

We support the implementation of Transportation Demand Management (TDM) programs by working with employers and assisting commuters. IN FY 2018/2019, the team held 740 meetings and events, including:

EMERGENCY RIDE HOME (ERH) PROGRAM

We encourage commuters to rethink their commute ... with confidence. In the event of a qualifying emergency, registered commuters can use this reimbursement program up to 4 times per year. Program participants include:

- 2,693 carpoolers and vanpoolers sharing the ride with others
- 2,337 transit riders taking the bus/train to work
- 270 cyclists and 125 walkers enjoying an active commute

IN FY 2018/2019:

- 2,531 commuters joined our regional program, for a total cumulative enrollment of 20,047 participants since the program launched in 2010
- 802 commuters were assisted through our call center
- 11,245 visits were made to our website, reThinkYourCommute.com
