reTHINK YOUR COMMUTE APP

n July 2019, we announced a new tool to help Central Floridians reThink their commute.

Offered as both a free smartphone app and desktop website, our new commuting platform combines a powerful ridematching solution with commuter trip tracking and rewards. In its first year of operation, we saw over 25,000 recorded trips representing a reduction of 544,295 vehicle miles traveled, \$314,545 in commuter savings and an offset of 241 tons of CO₂ in the air. reThinkers also burned over 675,000 calories by incorporating active transportation into their commutes.

Telework Webinar Series

Working from home has taken on new importance as many organizations have transitioned to telework to ensure employee safety and continued business operations. To help employers and employees navigate the shift to telecommuting, reThink Your Commute co-sponsored a three-part telework webinar series with other Florida CAP programs, Commute Connector (FDOT District 1) and Commute Tampa Bay (TBARTA/FDOT District 7). The webinar covered strategies for employers, collaborative technologies, and planning for the future.


